

Final Exploration Assignment

After exploring the various texts in this unit your task is to:

- a) Write a piece of prose which explores the following topic:

What is your opinion of the idea that significant events can determine an individual's perspective?

- b) Create a visual text which shows two different perspectives on a single event/object. This can be in any format but here are some suggestions:
- i. Mash-up
 - ii. Poster or diagram
 - iii. Sculpture
 - iv. Diorama
 - v. Film (be careful here because the visual elements need to be paramount)

The purpose of this unit is to, therefore, look at the idea of perspective and show how many events and objects can be viewed in various different ways depending on the individual and their background experience. Your task is to allow yourself to understand your own perspective and how it is determined and to then look more critically at the presentation of other people's perspectives and how they are formed.
